

Ephrata School District Bus Rules

For a Safe Trip To & From School

Parents/guardians, please review these rules with your student, then return the bottom portion to the driver.

1. The driver is in charge of the bus, obey the driver. Follow all procedures as instructed by the driver.
2. Student shall be at their designated bus stop 5 minutes prior to pick up time.
3. Students shall cross the street in front of the bus, NEVER behind it. Watch for the driver to signal that it is safe to cross the street.
4. Students shall ride their regular assigned bus and get off at their assigned stop, unless the driver is notified by the school with a bus pass.
5. Student shall not put any part of their body, or any object, out the bus windows. Students will not throw anything out of the bus windows.
6. Student shall remain in their seat at all times. They shall keep their body and any other objects out of the aisle, and observe classroom conduct.
7. For safety, student shall remain silent during the railroad crossing.
8. Student shall not bring glass, firearms, knives/weapons, tobacco/vapor, lighters/matches, hazardous materials, insects/animals, etc. on the bus.
9. Students shall not eat or drink on the bus without permission. Keep the bus clean.
10. Misconduct by students may cause cancellation of privilege.
