I trust this email finds you and your family safe and well.

Please know that the health and safety of our students and staff is our top priority in the Clintondale Community School District.

CCS is working closely with the Macomb County Health Department and carefully heeding the advice of the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) and the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).

Throughout the year, we encourage you to monitor your child for symptoms and temperature. If your child develops symptoms consistent with COVID-19, please contact your child's principal, as well as your primary care physician. Students that have symptoms should be kept home and families should reach out to their family physician for guidance before they return to school. If we are notified of a positive COVID-19 case, CCS will begin contact tracing and those close contacts will be notified.

Our COVID-19 protocols and procedures are created to mitigate transmission of the virus within district facilities, and we will closely observe developments in these cases to monitor the efficacy of our measures.

Here are other important actions we can all take to protect ourselves and others from this virus:

- Wash your hands regularly with soap and water. If soap and water are not available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer.
- Cover your nose and mouth with a tissue when you cough or sneeze – and remember to wash your hands afterwards.
- Avoid close contact with sick people.
- Clean and disinfect surfaces and objects that may be contaminated with germs.

Visitors and volunteers will be permitted inside school buildings on a limited basis. All visitors must check in at the front desk and follow building protocols for check-in. All visitors should have a pre-arranged appointment with the invitation or coordination of a CCS faculty or staff member. Drop-in visits are permitted.
