



7. Student vehicles may be subject to search if there are reasonable grounds to believe that drugs, alcohol, stolen property or other contraband might be present in that vehicle. The school retains authority to conduct routine patrols of student parking lots and inspections of the exteriors and visible interiors of student vehicles on school property. The interiors of student vehicles may be searched whenever a school official has reasonable cause or grounds for suspecting or believing that the search will turn up evidence that the individual student(s) has violated or is violating either the law or the rules of the school. Such patrols and searches may be conducted without notice, without student consent, and without a search warrant. Police may be called.

## **Parking Regulations for Gibson Ek High School**

Parking and driving are considered privileges. All parking and driving regulations are strictly enforced. Violations may lead to suspension of privileges, loss of privileges, fine/ticket, towing of vehicle and/or school discipline.

1. Parking on school premises is limited to those who have legally registered automobiles and driver's licenses, and who obtain a parking permit through the established process.
2. **Reproducing parking passes, including providing your pass for others or using a fake pass may result in any of the following: student discipline, parking tickets, towing, and/or immediate loss of parking privileges. The parking permit must be displayed in the front windshield in clear view; if it is not clearly visible, the car will be in violation and the car will be ticketed or towed.** Lost or stolen permits may be replaced for a \$10.00 fee.
3. **If you wish to dispute a ticket, you must contact the school office within 2 days of the date on the ticket or the ticket will stay in place.**
4. Student parking areas are reserved for students who pay the fee for a parking spot and agree to abide by the reserved parking area rules. Reservations are assigned for the entire school year. Students must pay the fee by the designated deadline or they will forfeit the reserved spot. The fee is \$140 for the school year.
5. Students are NOT to park in the following areas:
  - Visitor/Staff
  - Bus loading zone/Fire lanes/or any zone painted yellow
  - In handicapped zones, unless student has a handicap parking permit
  - In Clark Elementary School parking lot or driveways
  - In the Community Center or Boehm Pool
6. If you get a new car during the year, go immediately to the office and register it. Students are responsible for notifying the school if they change cars during the school year and for having the vehicle properly registered. Any vehicle that is not properly registered will be ticketed.
7. Consequences for violations may range from a fine, towing of vehicle, school discipline or loss of parking privileges.
8. Unpaid fines: A student with three or more unpaid tickets will immediately forfeit his/her reserved space and will be ineligible for the next parking lottery. All tickets go on the student's fine record and must be paid prior to registration the following year or graduation, yearbook and transcript release.

- Parking in the bus lane or fire lane

2<sup>nd</sup> Offense: Tow vehicle, disciplinary action, loss of parking privileges
- Parking in Visitor Parking or Handicap Zone  
1<sup>st</sup> Offense: \$25.00 fine  
2<sup>nd</sup> Offense: \$50.00 fine  
3<sup>rd</sup> Offense: Tow vehicle, loss of parking privileges
- Parking in Community Center, Boehm Pool or Clark Elementary  
1<sup>st</sup> Offense: \$25.00 fine, Tow vehicle  
2<sup>nd</sup> Offense: \$50.00 fine, Tow vehicle
- Speeding/Reckless Driving  
1<sup>st</sup> Offense: \$25.00 fine  
2<sup>nd</sup> Offense: \$50.00 fine  
3<sup>rd</sup> Offense: \$50.00 fine, school disciplinary action, loss of parking privileges, police notification
- Unregistered vehicle in any school parking space  
1<sup>st</sup> Offense: \$25.00 fine  
2<sup>nd</sup> Offense: \$50.00 fine  
3<sup>rd</sup> Offense: Tow vehicle
- No Parking Tag Displayed  
1<sup>st</sup> Offense: \$25.00 fine  
2<sup>nd</sup> Offense: \$50.00 fine  
3<sup>rd</sup> Offense: Loss of Parking Privilege
- Not Being in assigned space/taking up multiple spaces  
1<sup>st</sup> Offense: \$25.00 fine  
2<sup>nd</sup> Offense: \$50.00 fine  
3<sup>rd</sup> Offense: Loss of Parking Privilege
- Using an expired parking tag  
1<sup>st</sup> Offense: \$50.00 fine,  
2<sup>nd</sup> offense: student placed on tow contract  
3<sup>rd</sup> offense: Car is towed
- Reproducing and/or copying a parking tag  
1<sup>st</sup> offense: \$50.00 Fine, student placed on tow contract  
2<sup>nd</sup> offense: Car is towed
