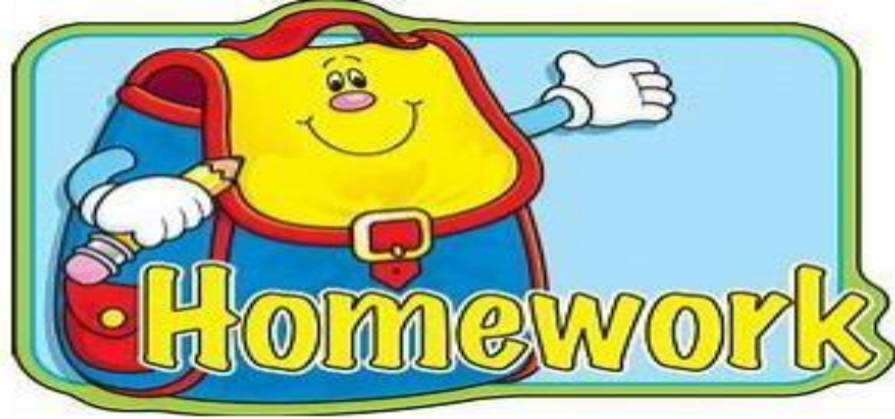
# Recess

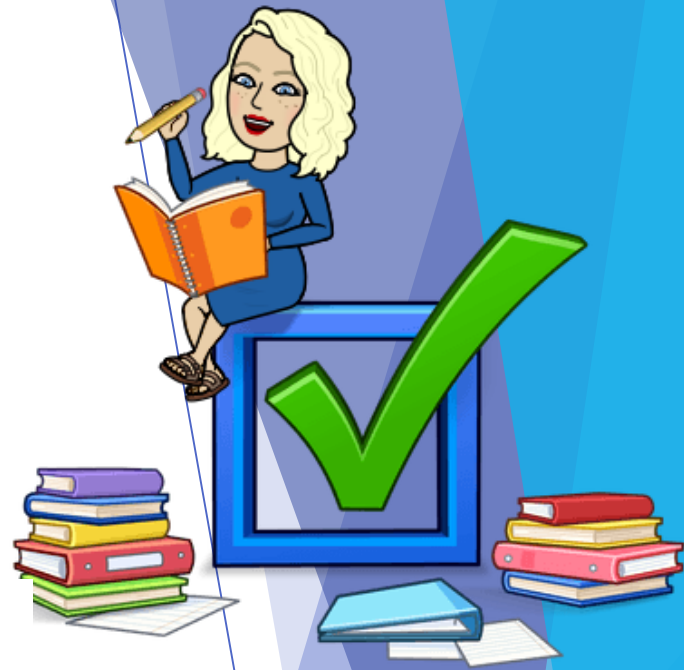
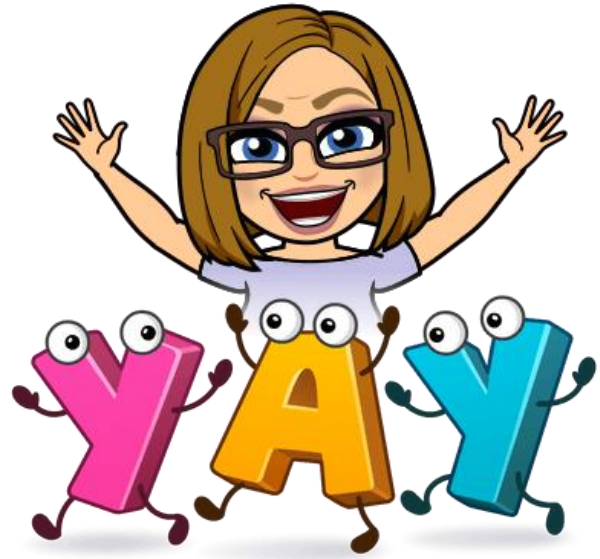
- ▶ Kindergarteners need their rest to do their best!
