I. Call to Order- —Danielle Dunbar, PTO President, at 7:00pm.

II. Approval of last meeting's minutes was approved by Jen Latzlesberger.

III. Board Reports-

- A. Treasurer's Report: Anti-Fundraiser has brought in \$2,375. Membership is at \$1,085 (122 families and 17 staff). Joe Corbis sales hit \$17,969.50 (approx. 8,500 revenue for PTO). Expenses- Jump rope assembly (\$1,000) and agenda books (\$1,001).
- B. Principal's Report: New online sign-ups for parent-teacher conferences have been sent out via email. Asking for patience as kinks are being worked out. Please check with office with questions. The two conference dates and times are set in teacher contracts. Teachers may be able to work out with parents other times (phone or planning time) to hold conferences. Please communicate with your child's teacher. Interims are out. Please discuss with your children about Growth Mindset and Goal Setting. Ask them what going around in their classrooms in relation to these two topics. PBIS-first round for ROAR tickets is complete. Administration visited the Cafeteria on October 15th to hand out certificates to one winner in each grade.

VI. Open Forum-

- A. Fun Run- Used to be in the Fall but will be in the Spring this year on March 5th. Will be ran by "Booster-Thon." They will be coming to our November Board meeting. More information to come!
- B. PTO Funds- What will the PTO use funds for in the years coming? Previously we used \$\$ towards the new playground and towards technology (computers). The Admin and PTO have a 5 year plan for all classes to gain a Computer set. The sets are \$3,000 so it should take 5-5 ½ years to get a set for each class in the school. Last year was the first year the PTO could partner and help pay for tech. Admin and PTO will revisit every year.
- C. Water- Parents explained that child comes home complaining the water is "yucky and white." Admin assured that the water has been tested and is safe. The school has well-water. The PTO and Admin will research options and price out what it would cost to install a "Water Bottle Refill Fountain." Will also talk to Robert about the concern.
