Updates From the Health Office December 2021

All things Covid

As we prepare for second semester and the likelihood of increased COVID cases after winter break, we are asking parents of students who have received the vaccine to provide documentation of their student's COVID vaccine to the school nurse. While COVID vaccine documentation is not required, it helps the school nurses in two ways:

1. Students who are asymptomatic, with documentation of being fully vaccinated, are not excluded from school if exposed to a positive case.

2. Nurses can better estimate the number of fully vaccinated students in a building which is useful information when there are outbreaks.

Again, while COVID vaccine documentation is not required, it would be helpful to the school nurses.

COVID-19 Vaccines

Vaccines are available to individuals age 5 and older through the Johnson County Department of Health and Environment. <u>Appointments must be</u> <u>made</u> for first, second, additional or booster COVID-19 vaccines. JCDHE is not able to accommodate walk-ins for COVID-19 vaccinations. Vaccines are



also available at <u>JCDHE's community vaccine clinics</u>, through <u>local health care</u> <u>systems</u> and at <u>local pharmacies</u>. Get yours today so you can have a safe and Healthy Holiday.



XELLO



Xello is a college and career readiness program designed to help organize student plans in one centralized location. Students complete Xello lessons during their advisory period for the purpose of equipping students with the knowledge and planning capabilities to help them navigate their future.



Conversation Starters

If you would like to discuss your student's Xello survey results and lessons with your student, here is a list of some conversation starters

- 1. What are some of the most exciting results you learned about from your Xello Match Maker?
- 2. Were you surprised by any of your results, and why?
- 3. What are some of the career matches that were suggested to you?
- 4. What are your overall thoughts about some of the career matches that were suggested to you? What are you most excited about, and why?
- 5. What are some of the classes that were suggested that you could take to help you work towards your future goals? What are your thoughts about these classes, and why?

Ways to Build Interest

As a parent, there is a lot you can do to help your child get excited about their future. Here are some of the ways that are suggested by Xello:

- 1. Talk about what your job means to you.
