Community Reinvestment Act (CRA) Scholarship

Scholarship Objective

To support the academic endeavors of low-to-moderate income students with a desire to continue their higher education.

Scholarship Award

1. The Springs Valley Bank & Trust Community Reinvestment Act (CRA) Scholarship, in the amount of \$1,000, will be awarded to one (1) eligible recipient. The Scholarship must be used by the recipient to cover tuition, fees, books, and supplies while pursuing studies in a degree program at a college or university approved by the Scholarship Committee.
2. The Scholarship Committee, which is appointed by Springs Valley Bank & Trust Company (Springs Valley), will select the recipient from the applications received on or before **February 28, 2022**.
3. In the event a recipient receives a full scholarship from another source, any award received from Springs Valley will be withdrawn.
4. If the recipient cannot accept the award or will not be attending school the next semester, it will go to the next qualified recipient in order of merit, as determined by the Scholarship Committee.
5. When the selection has been made, the recipient will be notified in writing by Springs Valley by **April 30, 2022**.
6. The \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to the recipient by **August 1, 2022**.

Eligibility Criteria

All applicants must:

1. Meet the following income requirement: Annual gross family income cannot exceed \$51,680, which is 80% of the median income for non-MSA counties in Indiana for year 2021. This should include all income of everyone over the age of 18 living in the home.
2. Be a high school graduate or equivalent.
3. Be enrolled or eligible for admission as a degree candidate at a college or university approved by the Scholarship Committee.
4. Use the awarded scholarship during the upcoming academic year.
5. Be a current resident of Crawford, Daviess, Dubois, Gibson, Martin, or Orange Counties.
6. Springs Valley associates and associates' families are excluded.

How to Apply

1. Complete the attached Scholarship Application form. Please type or print legibly in black ink.
2. Send the completed application along with:
 - a. A completed Scholarship Application form.
 - b. A copy of your official high school transcripts and official transcripts from any other schools that you have attended since high school. (Former scholarship recipients reapplying for the scholarship must submit official transcripts or grade reports from the institution they have attended.)
 - c. Three letters of recommendation/reference. One letter must be employment or academic related and two must be character references. Please attach this information to the application.
 - d. Write a 500-word essay stating your aims and goals in obtaining further education. Please refer to the application for essay details.
 - e. Proof of income qualification. Examples include proof of public assistance, a copy of your most recent tax return or any other valid verification. A photocopy is sufficient.

3. The completed application and supporting documents must be received on or before **February 28, 2022**.
4. After the Scholarship Committee has reviewed each application, selected applicants may be informed of a date, time, and location for an interview with the Scholarship Committee, after which the final selection will be made.
