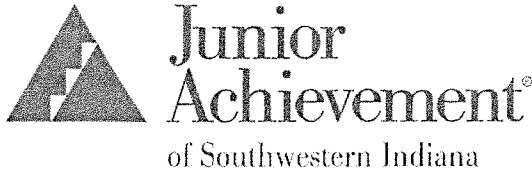
Attached are eligibility requirements, scholarship policies, procedures, and the official application.

**The deadline for all scholarship applications is Tuesday, March 1, 2022. Turn in the completed application and essay to Ruth Wilson at Junior Achievement ([ruth.wilson@ja.org](mailto:ruth.wilson@ja.org) or 431 E. Diamond Ave. Evansville, IN 47711)**

**Eligibility Requirements:**

- Applicant must be a Senior with a cumulative un-weighted GPA of at least 2.8 and must be in good standing with his or her high school.
- Applicant should have participated in a JA program.
- Applicant must be planning to attend a two or four-year program at a college, university or technical school.
- Applicant must submit a complete application to be considered for the scholarship. **The deadline for all applications is Tuesday, March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022 at 3:00 pm (ET) to Ruth Wilson at Junior Achievement ([ruth.wilson@ja.org](mailto:ruth.wilson@ja.org)).** Applications preferably should be typed. If applicant cannot get application typed, they may use black ink and print neatly.

- Applications should preferably be typed. If you cannot get your application typed, use black ink and print neatly.
- **The winner will be required to read his/her essay at the Junior Achievement Dubois County Business Hall of Fame Recognition Breakfast event in Spring, 2022 at 7:30 a.m. at Huntingburg Event Center. Date to be determined and will be communicated to the scholarship winner.**

**Scholarship Policies and Procedures:**

- The scholarship selection committee is made up of educators, JA Board Members and business professionals. This committee makes the final selection of the scholarship recipients based on the factors mentioned above. The scholarship recipient will be announced by April 1, 2022. The decision of the committee is final.
- The recipients must submit a written proof of enrollment at a technical school, college or university to the Junior Achievement office in order to receive the scholarship money.
- The scholarship check will be made directly to the Financial Aid Office at the college or university the recipient will be attending. The award may be used toward tuition, fees, books or other required school expenses.
