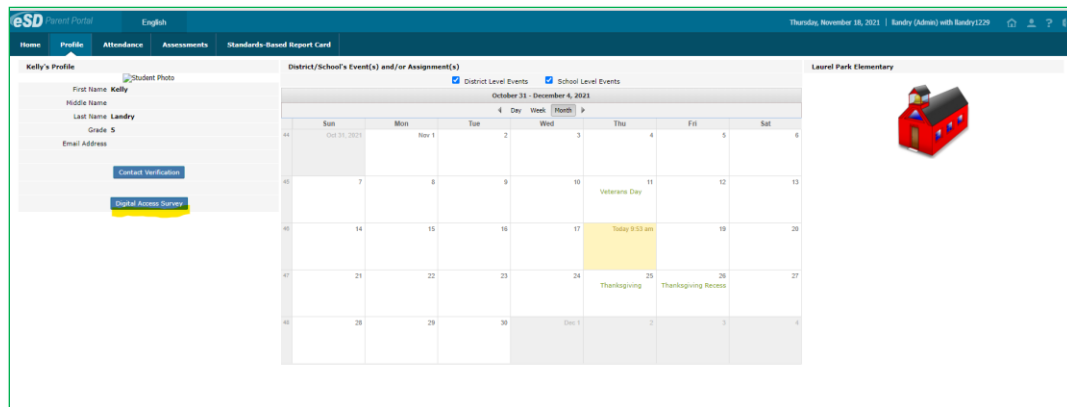



## Digital Equity Survey in Parent Portal

### Digital Equity Survey

The New York State Education Department (NYSED) is conducting a Digital Equity Survey for all public-school districts, charter schools, and BOCES across the state. The purpose of this survey is to understand and promote educational equity, including digital equity for all students in New York State. The Digital Equity Survey responses can be completed in the Brentwood Parent Portal.

After selecting the student from the Parent Portal Homepage, a **Digital Access Survey** button will be displayed on the student's Profile page for the custodial parent(s). Clicking the **Digital Access Survey** button opens the survey.

- Question 1: Did the school district issue your child a dedicated school or district-owned device for their use during the school year? (Yes/No)
- Question 2: What is the device your child uses most often to complete learning activities away from school? (This can be a school-provided device or another device, whichever the student is most often using to complete their schoolwork.) (Desktop, Laptop, Tablet, Chromebook, Smartphone, No Device)
- Question 3: Who is the provider of the primary learning device identified in question 2? (This can be a school-provided device or another device, whichever the student is most often using to complete their schoolwork.) (Personal, School, No Device)
- Question 4: Is the primary learning device (identified in question 2) shared with anyone else in the household? (No Device, Shared, Not Shared)
- Question 5: Is the primary learning device (identified in question 2) sufficient for your child to fully participate in all learning activities away from school? (Yes/No)
- Question 6: Is your child able to access the internet in their primary place of residence? (Yes/No)
- Question 7: What is the primary type of internet service used in your child's primary place of residence? (Residential Broadband, Cellular)

The survey consists of nine questions created by NYSED. One survey is to be filled out for each K-12 student you have enrolled in the district. Please note that **All** questions must be answered for a completed survey.
