MRC Student wins Breathitt County Essay Contest

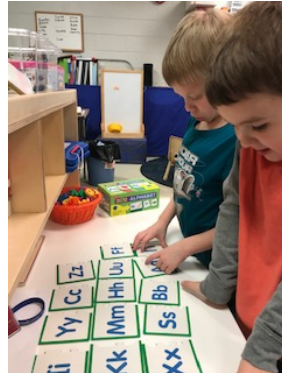

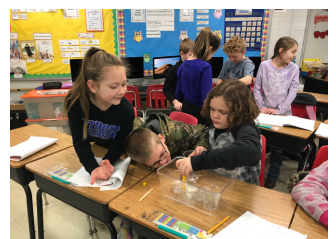
Mrs. Nobles preschool class utilizing the new math and literacy centers that were recently purchased through a grant by the board of education.
