Reminders upon completion of high school:

- 1) FAFSA needs to be filled out January 1st each year in order to get on the list for financial aid (if you're eligible for aid). Use last year's tax information and input the new information once your taxes are finished. Always use: <http://www.fafsa.ed.gov/> If you forget your pin, request for your pin, enter the password you made last year and click display now. The pin will appear then. □ If you have trouble with your FAFSA, call 1-800-433-3243**
- 2) Don't forget John Raymond Turner scholarship, this is a scholarship you can receive up to four years in college-it's for Breathitt County residents. You can print the form here: <http://turnereducationalfoundation.org/>**
- 3) Check with your financial aid officer at your college for scholarship information and ask the place you work if they offer scholarships-IGA for instance offers scholarships.**
