

I. SELF-PORTRAIT

We ask each applicant to create a Self-Portrait as part of their application. The Self-Portrait should be a project that expresses something about who you are and/or something you care about. You may use any medium or art-form. It might be an original essay, a letter, news article, poem, painting, collage, photograph, drawing, sculpture, or textile project. You can record your voice, compose a piece of music, or make a video. Please submit your self-portrait in person or upload your project using the **link** in your Application Checklist online.

Have fun with your project, but make sure you tell us what you think we should know about you! Also, see the **required Part II** below.

II. ACADEMIC WORK SAMPLE

Please submit a piece of **academic work** that you are particularly proud of from the current school year. You might choose a report, a science project, or a main lesson book, for example. Upload via link if possible.

Don't worry if there are teacher's comments on it. We would like to see them.

III. RETRIEVING YOUR PROJECTS

Once decision letters are mailed in March, you are welcome to pick up your self-portrait and work sample if they are physical objects you wish to keep. Please be sure to put your name on your project!
