

INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT

2011-12

This Interlocal Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into by and between South Whidbey School District No. 206 ("South Whidbey SD") and the Coupeville School District No. 204 ("Coupeville SD").

RECITALS


- A. The parties are public agencies, as defined in RCW 39.34.020, who wish to enter into an agreement pursuant to RCW Chapter 39.34.
- B. The parties have each taken the appropriate action, by ordinance, resolution or otherwise, to authorize the execution and implementation of this agreement.

AGREEMENTS

1. Duration. This agreement shall become effective upon final signatures and filing of executed documents pursuant to RCW 39.34.040. The term of this agreement shall terminate on August 31, 2012.
2. Purpose. The purpose of this agreement is to provide services for homeless children and youth as a partner district of the Title X Part C consortium grant #0455065 provided through OSPI for the 2011-12 school year.
3. Services. Coupeville SD agrees to use the funds allocated for a McKinney-Vento support specialist who will assist with the mandated liaison responsibilities and connect homeless students and families with community resources. The specialist may also provide McKinney-Vento training within the district.
4. Payment for Services. The South Whidbey School District shall reimburse the Coupeville School District up to \$5,000 for these services. Payment will be made on a reimbursement basis with appropriate documentation to support the requested reimbursement. Reimbursement requests made by the 5th of the month will be paid at month's end.
5. Reporting. Coupeville SD shall maintain records, documents and other evidence, which sufficiently and properly reflects all costs expended in the performance of this contract. These records shall be subject at all reasonable times to inspection, review or audit by personnel duly authorized by law, rules, regulation or contract. All records, documents or other material relevant to this grant shall be retained for six (6) years after settlement and make them available for inspection by persons authorized under this provision.
6. Suspension & debarment. Coupeville SD certifies they are not presently debarred, suspended, proposed for debarment or declared ineligible or voluntarily excluded for the award of contracts by any federal governmental agency or department. Coupeville SD shall provide immediate written notice of any change to this status.

7. Breach of Contract. In the event either party breaches its obligations under this agreement, the breaching party shall compensate the other for direct costs resulting from such breach: but all claims for consequential damages and costs are waived.
