Dear Lamoille North Families/Households with School-Age Children:

This is a follow up to our letter home yesterday regarding free COVID-19 testing for all students. To help prevent the spread of COVID-19 in our communities as Vermont students return to school, we are encouraging you to have each school-age child in your household take two COVID-19 rapid tests. If you so choose, please have your child(ren) take these tests at least 24 hours apart, starting two days before school begins. So, if your child begins school on January 3, 2022, they should take the first test on January 1st and the second test on January 2nd.

If your child's test result is positive, please report your positive test results to the Vermont Department of Health (VTDOH) by clicking [HERE](#).

If you do have a positive test result, please click [HERE](#) for instructions about isolating, contact tracing, etc.

If both of your child's test results are negative and your child is asymptomatic, your child can return to school.

Any child experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 should stay home from school regardless of their test result.
