HOLLISTON

It is the policy of the Holliston Public Schools to endeavor to provide a safe environment in which students and staff can learn and participate in all programs offered or sponsored by the Holliston Public Schools. Providing for the safety of students, employees, volunteers, and visitors while at school or school sponsored activities is the responsibility of all students, employees, volunteers, and visitors. If any individual confronts a situation which he/she considers to be unsafe for any reason, he/she should take all reasonable steps within his/her ability to eliminate the potential harm to others or him/herself, and thereafter report the circumstances to the building principal in accordance with the Holliston School District Crisis Management Plan. The Superintendent may from time to time develop procedures to carry out this policy.
