Administrators will work tomorrow to plan for a safe reopening of schools on Tuesday, January 4, 2022.

The District will continue to follow Addendum 5 guidelines and our own policy regarding Covid 19. We accept positive test results via PCR, Rapid, and home tests. We will continue to work with the DPH and the SDE on updating the latest protocols, which have been revised, and will be reviewed with districts this coming week.
