Important Information:

1. Documentation of boat registration and insurance must be provided and in the same name as the mooring applicant.
2. This mooring permit is non-transferable (Title 38, Chapter 1, Subchapter 1, §3) and is for the use of the above-named person and boat only, except on a temporary basis at the discretion of the Harbor Master.
3. Location of moorings will be assigned by the Harbor Master or Deputy. This location is subject to change at any time at the discretion of the Harbor Master or Deputy as condition dictate.
4. Holder of permit is responsible for setting mooring and adjusting as required for the safety of this boat and adjacent boats.
5. Mooring buoys shall be white with a 3-inch blue reflectorized band clearly visible above the water; the buoy shall extend a minimum of 12 inches above the surface of the water, and shall have at least 1 square foot of surface visible from any direction.
6. Mooring number must be painted on mooring buoy in at least 3-inch letters of a contrasting color to ball.
7. The valid mooring registration sticker must be affixed to the boat on the port side following the State registration sticker.
8. If any boat on a licensed mooring is taking on water or in danger of sinking, the Harbor Master may authorize a private contractor to pump out said boat at the expense of the owner. The owner must pay the contractor within 60 days or owner will lose mooring privileges.
9. Completed applications with all supporting documentation must be submitted prior to April 1 or will be subject to a fine of not less than \$100.00 nor more than \$500.00 plus costs.
10. All moorings and boats must be in by July 1 or the location will be re-assigned according to waiting list priority.
11. Mooring fees once approved: \$300.00 Resident Recreational/Real Estate Taxpayer of Scarborough; \$500.00 Resident Commercial /Real Estate Taxpayer of Scarborough; \$500.00 Non-Resident Recreational; \$700.00 Non-Resident Commercial
