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**Important Information to Know:**

1. Mooring permits are non-transferable and for the use of the above-named boat only, except on a temporary basis at the discretion of the Harbor Master.
2. Location of all NEW moorings will be assigned by the Harbor Master or Deputy. The location is subject to change at any time at the discretion of the Harbor Master or Deputy as conditions dictate.
3. Holder of mooring permit is responsible for setting mooring and making adjustments as required for the safety of this boat and adjacent boats.
4. Mooring number must be painted on mooring buoy in at least 3-inch letters of a contrasting color to ball.
5. The valid mooring registration sticker must be affixed to the boat on the port side following the State registration sticker.
6. If any boat on a licensed mooring is taking on water or in danger of sinking, the Harbor Master may authorize a private contractor to pump out said boat at the expense of the owner. The owner must pay the contractor within 60 days or owner will lose mooring privileges.
7. Registration form and fee must be received **before May 1 each year** or the fee will double. All moorings not registered by July 1 of each year will be considered abandoned and cut loose and their location re-assigned, unless prior arrangements have been made with the Harbor Master.

***Please Note:*** All moorings must be in by July 1 or the location will be re-assigned according to waiting list priority.

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Mooring fees once approved: Resident/Scarborough Real Estate Taypayer: \$50.00/year Non-Resident: \$100.00/year
