

If I could I would love to solve prejudice.



I would like to help solve the problem of education. I feel that the school system for impoverished kids and kids in general does not promote learning as much as it should.





I would like to work on genetic modification of bacteria, archaea, and virae, in order to solve problems, like waste disposal and bacterial microbiome-related problems.



Language Arts.


