I'm not sure what problem I want to solve, but I know I will need to focus on hard work, patience, empathy, gratitude, and good judgment.

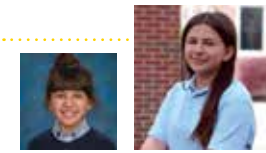

Mr. Grime's history class, we cover so many problems of today and his class really helps you learn how to form an opinion and debate, which I think is extremely important.

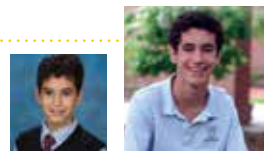

I think speech class prepares you most because it makes you more confident and comfortable talking in front of big crowds.

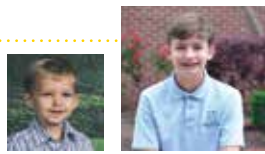

When I grow up, I would like to study and discover diseases to prevent them and cure them.

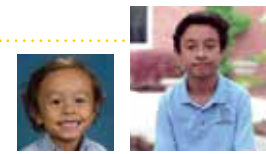

Mathematics. I think this because there are many classes that include it, and many jobs have some mathematics in it. However, every class is important depending on what you want to do with your life.

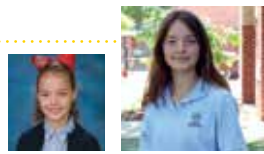

I would like to solve the problem of Cardiac Arrest Rates. The rate of death due to cardiac arrest is climbing, and I would like to solve this one day.

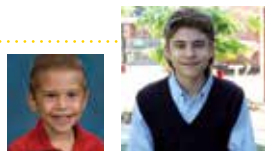

History. You learn how to debate, converse, and talk about current events. The class is different and unique from all other learning styles.

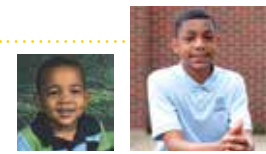

I believe that math prepares you the most especially algebra because it can be used in every day experiences.

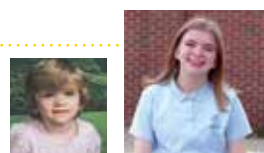

I want to solve problems with tech.

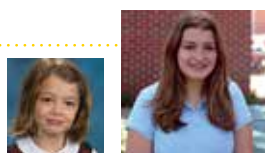

I would like to find a way to cure obscure diseases in animals.

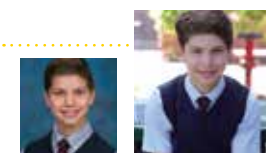

I think that math will prepare me for life after middle school because this year in math we learned about consuming. For example taking out loans, buying a car, and buying a house.

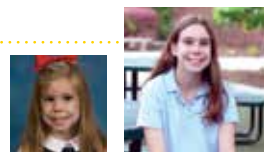

There are too many problems for me to just pick one, but I know that I will have to work hard to solve them.

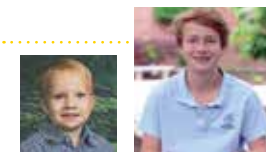
