RANKING POLICY

Second Baptist School is a non-ranking school. Students are ranked solely to identify those who fall within the top ten percent after six semesters. Students are placed in quartiles based on their cumulative GPA.

The cumulative GPA is calculated each semester with additional weight given to advanced-level courses. Honors and AP courses receive an additional 1.0 point and honors courses not leading to an AP course receive an additional 0.5 point. In order to be eligible for graduation, a student must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0.
