ARTICLE III: SCOPE OF WORK

A. OVERVIEW OF KENNEWICK SCHOOL DISTRICT #17 FOOD SERVICE

The SPONSOR provides food service to approximately 19,000 18,338 enrolled students at 29 schools. The food service prepares approximately 876,280 860,541 breakfasts, 1,661,807 lunches, 23,165 after school snacks and 133,182 after school suppers annually. Summer meals include approximately 14,438 breakfasts and 25,272 lunches.

The SPONSOR shall be legally responsible for the conduct of the food service program and shall supervise the food service operations in such manner as will ensure compliance with the rules and regulations of OPSI and USDA regarding each Child Nutrition Programs (CNP) covered by the resulting contract.

The SPONSOR shall retain signature authority for the monthly claim for reimbursement in the Washington Integrated Nutrition System (WINS).

 The SPONSOR shall retain control and signature authority of the CNP nonprofit food service account and overall financial responsibility for the CNP. (7 CFR210.16 (a)(4)(5))
