

Application for Directed Study

A directed study may be taken on those rare occasions when a catalog course that a student needs for his/her major is not being offered in time for the student to graduate. Approval to take a directed study (see signatures below) must be granted by the end of the drop/add period of the semester in which the student plans to take the course. The following conditions apply:

- The student must have a cumulative GPA of 2.00
- A student will not be allowed to take a directed study course to repeat a course in which a grade of “D” or “F” was previously earned.
