**PBIS Slogan: Success Through Actions... The STA Way!**

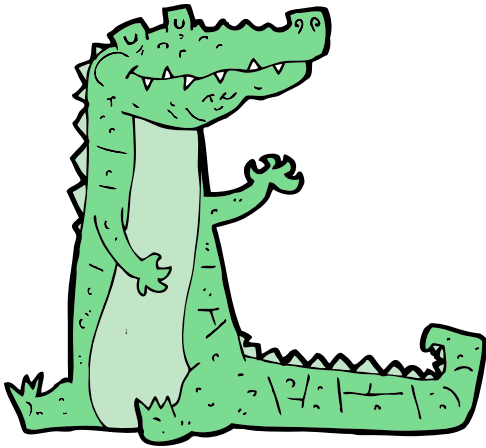
**What is PBIS?** Positive behavioral interventions and supports (PBIS) is an approach that schools use to improve school safety and promote positive behavior.

**When are students taught about positive behaviors and interactions with others?**

Weekly Advisory lessons are created based on the needs of students and discipline data.

**How do students know they are exhibiting positive behaviors?**

Gator Green is given by teachers for exhibiting positive behaviors. Things students are rewarded for include, but are not limited to, helping others, being positive, making good decisions, doing homework, and having a visible ID or following dress code.



**What can students do with Gator Green?**

- Skip in the lunch line (3 GG)
- Buy concessions (6 GG)
- Dress down during midterms and finals (10 GG)
- Buy back a class reward (10 GG)
- Redeem for Athletic game ticket (20 GG)

**Monthly Focus:**

Each month the PBIS team decides on a focus area to target. The class who earns the most points by getting the fewest violations receives a class reward.

**August Focus: IDs**

Students are issued an ID as a safety measure. All students have received an ID and should wear it daily.

**Gator of the Month (GOM) Breakfast:**

Another PBIS initiative at STA is our Gator of the Month breakfast. All teachers are asked to select one student from their classes who has exhibited positive behaviors and attitude, improved in behavior or attitude or who overall exhibits the success through actions motto. Students who earn this honor are given a certificate and are provided with donuts and juice/milk at our monthly breakfast.
