

## Drew Charter School COVID-19 Weekly Case Report (Week of January 1st)

*Includes all cases reported to Drew during this 7-day timeframe*

When Drew Charter School nurses are notified of a confirmed-positive COVID-19 case, they submit a form to the Atlanta Public Schools (APS) Health Services department and to DeKalb Department of Public Health. When a positive case is reported amongst Drew students or staff or in an extra-curricular environment, COVID-19 protocols go into effect.

The summary below includes self-reported cases, presumptive positive cases and associated exposures reported in the last week among students and staff screened through on-campus drive-through testing or at Drew's Elementary Academy or Junior/Senior Academy campus during the school week.

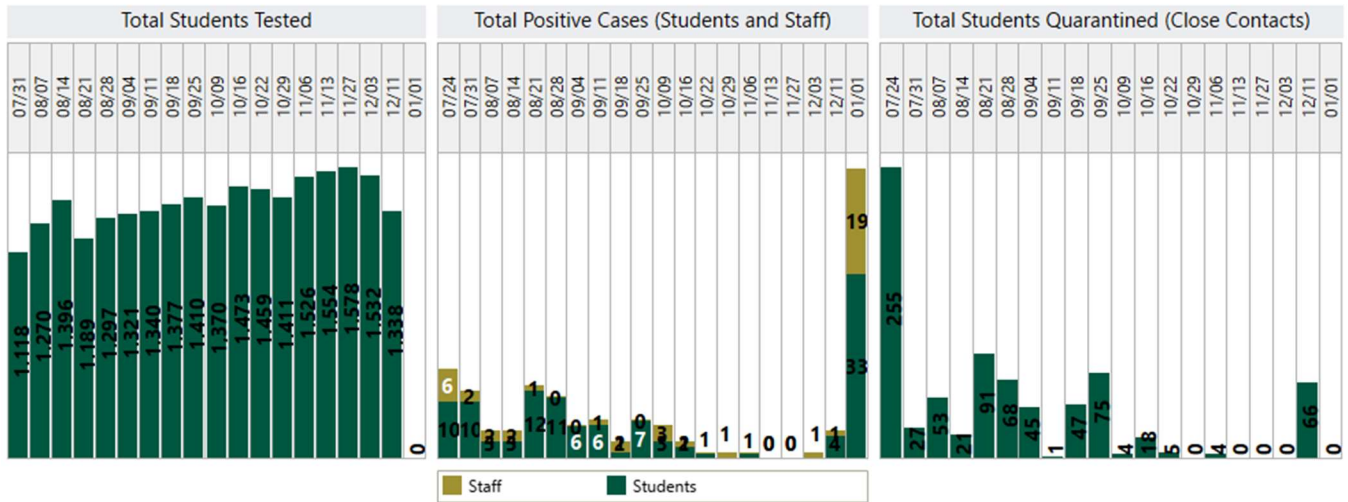

*\*Includes students who were identified during contact tracing as having close contact with a student or staff member who has tested positive for COVID-19; No students tested during virtual school week.*

Note: A case is defined as an individual with a laboratory-confirmed COVID-19 positive from either antigen (rapid) or PCR (nasal swab) tests; external positive cases are self-reported. Exposures are the close contacts of cases from school, work, and extracurricular settings. Exposures are aggregated from individual case reports and may not represent unique exposures.

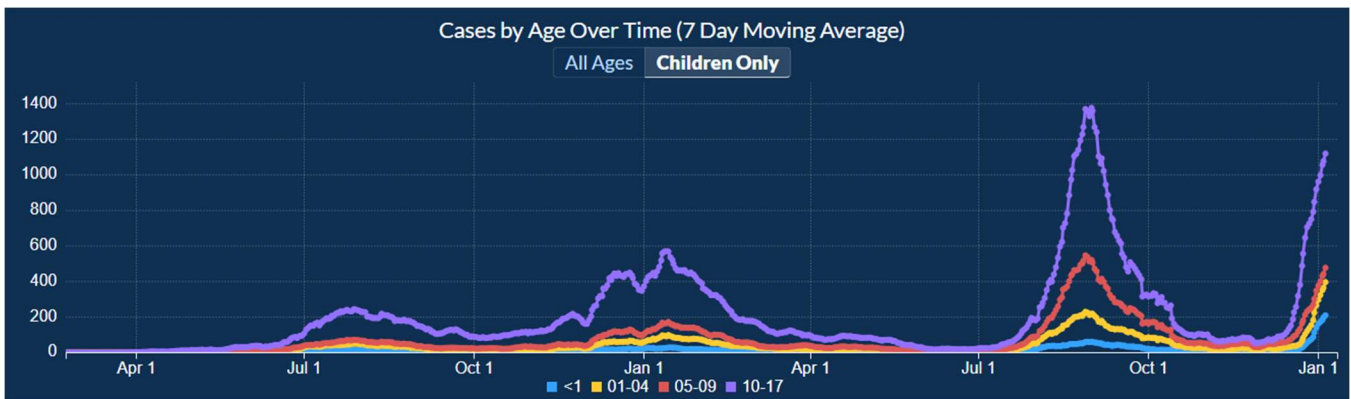
## Longitudinal Weekly Reporting (7/24 – 1/7/2022)
