



SHOULD I REPORT TO SCHOOL?

**POSITIVE
COVID-19
TEST**

I have tested positive for Covid-19:

Students and Employees who test positive for the virus are to stay home for 5 days.

After 5 days at home, if the student or employee no longer has symptoms, they may return to school and wear a face covering for another 5 days.

**SHOWING
SYMPTOMS**

I am showing symptoms for Covid-19:

The best measure to prevent the spread of the virus is to stay home when you are not feeling well.

If you have fever and/or cold-like symptoms, you should stay home and be tested.

**EXPOSED

Symptoms**

I have been exposed to someone who has Covid-19:

I am a student.

I am an employee.

I am vaccinated.

-come to school and wear a face covering around others for 10 days.

I am unvaccinated.

-stay home for 5 days.

-if you have no symptoms, return to school and wear a face covering around others for 5 additional days.

I am vaccinated.

-report to work and wear a face covering around others for 10 days.

I am unvaccinated.

-stay home for 5 days.

-if you have no symptoms, return to school and wear a face covering around others for 5 additional days.

*note: if you have completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine **more than 6 months ago** and **are not boosted**, OR completed the primary series of J&J more than **2 months ago** and **are not boosted**: you are considered unvaccinated.
