**Enrollment Fee.** This annual fee places the student on the school roster, thereby confirming their enrollment at BCS. It is due upon enrollment and **non-refundable** once billed or paid. The enrollment fee is not a deposit on, nor a prepayment of, tuition.

**Priority Re-Enrollment.** Open only to current BCS students re-enrolling for the 2022-2023 school year. Tuition accounts must be current. Open enrollment begins February 1 for all new families wishing to enroll in BCS. Returning students not reenrolled by January 28 may be waitlisted; students reenrolling after January 28 pay the open enrollment fee.

**Annual Tuition**

- May be paid in full by May 1 with a 2% discount if paid by check (offer expires May 2).
- May be paid in full by May 1 by card, Flywire, or wire transfer (no discount, no credit card or wire fees; fees apply beginning May 2). **To avoid card convenience fee, card must be run through school and not VC Pay. Contact Student Billing for details.**
- May be paid in two installments. The first payment is due on or before May 1 paying 80% of annual tuition, and second payment is due on or before November 1, paying last 20% of annual tuition. Not eligible for pay-in-full discounts. Pay by check, wire, Flywire, or VC Pay.
- Tuition assistance not available.

**\*Required Tuition Account Deposits** for student's I-20 and expenses during the school year. Deposit for new student I-20 (\$5,000) is non-refundable, is a deposit on annual tuition, and reduces May 1 payment. (I-20 deposit not required for returning students.) Deposit for expenses for all students as follows:

- ◇ **Grades K-6.** Expense deposit of \$500 per family. If family has a student in grades 7-12, the elementary expense deposit is waived.
- ◇ **Grades 7-12.** Expense deposit of \$1,000 per student.

Expense deposit is replenished each year. Expense deposit remaining in tuition account after paying all fees or tuition is refunded at graduation or withdrawal.

NOTE: Bus fee, insurance, and textbooks and materials required for JH/SH classes are not covered by the expense deposit.

**Payment Terms**

- First installment payment or payment in full is due by May 1 and will avoid late fees if payment is received by May 5.
- Second installment payment is due by November 1 and will avoid late fees if payment is received by November 5.
- Late payment made between the 6th and 19th of May (and/or November) will be subject to a \$15 late fee.
- Late payment made after the 19th of May (and/or November) will be subject to an additional \$50 late fee.
- Any check that is returned for any reason will be subject to a \$25 fee.
- Bank and card payments made through VC Pay will be subject to convenience fee.
- Students may not attend classes or participate in co-curricular activities beginning the first day of school and/or second semester, if payment has not been made by due date.

**Force Majeure.** In the event of school closure beyond the school's control, the School's duties and obligations will be postponed until such time as the School, in its sole discretion, may safely reopen and/or comply with its duties and obligations. Details are found in online re/enrollment. A full description is provided in online enrollment.

**Withdrawals.** If a student withdraws after they have enrolled, tuition and fees accrued through the end of the semester of withdrawal are due regardless of the date of actual withdrawal. Tuition responsibility is as follows:
