Ways to keep in touch with your child's learning this term.

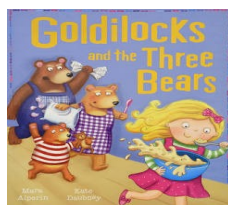
- Check our weekly Dear Parents letter with information on how to support your child at home sent to you via Parent Pay.

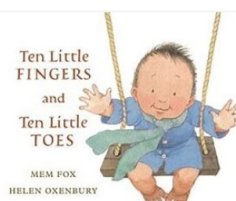

We will be acting out the stories, adding actions and creating story maps. We will also be looking at number poems like Five Little Men in A Flying Saucer.



Each week we will continue with our 'Rhyme of the Week'. This term will focus on rhymes linked to numbers to support our counting to five, counting back-

wards and taking one away each time.



Concept Cat and Word Aware.

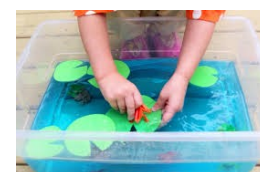
