Literacy

We will continue to explore stories around numbers and space such as Whatever Next and Aliens love underpants. As well as retelling stories like Goldilocks, we will be developing our spelling to write labels, captions and simple sentences.



Maths

This term we will be exploring numbers in different ways. We are planning a walk in the local environment where we will spot numbers, sequences and patterns. We will be developing our understanding of numbers through talking about what we have found out and how we have solved problems. We will also be learning some new number rhymes and poems and begin using the language of addition and subtraction when making amounts.

Outdoor learning will begin this term. You will receive a letter when it is your child's turn to take part. This will take part on a rotation basis across the rest of the year and you will be invited to bring in some old clothes and wellie boots to change into for the duration of their sessions.
