FRANKLIN PIERCE SCHOOLS PROPOSITIONS 1 AND 2



PROP 1: EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS AND OPERATIONS REPLACEMENT LEVY

Funds 15% of Franklin Pierce Schools operations



INVEST IN:

- Teachers and paraeducators to decrease class sizes and support academic achievement
- Counselors, social workers and mental health services to support social emotional development
- Safety, security and health professionals to support student health and safety
- Athletics, arts, music and activities to help students thrive



Prop 1 replaces an existing levy passed by voters in 2018 at \$4.74/ \$1,000 with a new levy set at \$2.50/\$1,000 from 2023-2026. This is not a tax rate increase and will provide vital funding for academic achievement, social emotional learning, health and safety, and expanded opportunities.

PROP 2: CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS TECHNOLOGY REPLACEMENT LEVY

Funds technology access for all students



INVEST IN:

- One computing device for each student
- 21st Century classroom technology
- Remote learning technology and access
- Cybersecurity infrastructure to protect students and staff
- IT support staff to service all students, staff and families



Prop 2 continues an existing levy passed by voters in 2018 at \$.41/1,000 with a new levy set at \$.41/\$1,000 to support continued investment in technology from 2023-2026. This is not a tax rate increase and will provide vital funding for technology access to support student learning.
