



COVID-19 Decision Tree – STAFF FULLY VACCINATED

STAFF Fully Vaccinated²

Remain on home isolation until all conditions are met:

- *At least 10 days have passed since the onset of symptoms, AND
- *Resolution of fever for at least 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medications, AND
- *Symptoms have improved

Encourage school staff not to retest for at least 90 days (unless known exposure and newly symptomatic)

Exposed to Confirmed Positive COVID-19 Case (CPC)

If exposed staff test is negative: follow one quarantine option below:

- *End after Day 7 if a test is collected on or after Day 5 from the date of last exposure and is (-) AND symptoms have improved AND fever free
- *End after Day 10 from the date of last exposure if not tested

For presumed positive case (PPC) test that is negative or when no exposure has occurred, a staff member who had symptoms may be released from isolation and return to work if:

Option 1:

- *COVID-19 test result is negative, AND
- *Symptoms have improved AND
- *Resolution of fever for at least 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medications

Option 2:

- *Health Care Provider has provided documentation that the symptoms are typical of their underlying chronic condition

Option 3:

- *Health Care Provider has confirmed an alternative diagnosis

Option 4:

- *At least 10 days have passed since symptom onset.

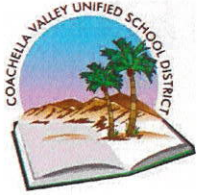

Remain on home isolation until all conditions are met:

- * At least 10 days have passed since the onset of symptoms, AND**

Encourage school staff not to retest for at least 90 days (unless known exposure and newly symptomatic)

***If exposed staff test is negative:** exposed staff must complete 10-day quarantine from the date of last exposure

***If exposed staff refuse to test:** exposed staff must complete 10-day quarantine from the date of last exposure

For presumed positive case that is negative or when no exposure has occurred, a staff member who had symptoms may be released from isolation and return to work if:

Option 1:

- *COVID-19 test result is negative, AND
- *Resolution of fever for at least 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medications, AND
- *Symptoms have improved

Option 2:

- *Health Care Provider has provided documentation that the symptoms are typical of their underlying chronic condition

Option 3:

- *Health Care Provider has confirmed an alternative diagnosis

Option 4:

- *At least 10 days have passed since the onset of symptoms

Exposed staff to follow one quarantine option below:

- *Quarantine can end after Day 7 if a test is collected on or after Day 5 from the date of last exposure and the test is negative **OR**
- *Quarantine can end after Day 10 from the date of last exposure without testing

Note: If exposed staff member has tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 90 days, they do not need to quarantine unless new symptoms develop. If it has been more than 90 days since (+) staff to follow quarantine above

Return To Work Upon Completion Quarantine/Isolation Per Protocols

Continue to work

²Fully vaccinated (14 days since last dose) or confirmed COVID-19 positive within 90 days
