



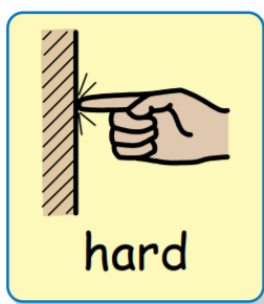
Dear Parents and Carers 10.1.22

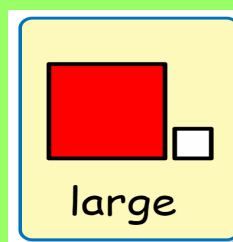
