New Lebanon School (NLS) is an authorized International Baccalaureate World School offering the Primary Years Programme, and was named a 2022 School of Distinction - High Growth (High Needs Students) - ELA by the Connecticut State Department of Education. Opened in 2019, the state-of-art award-winning building is Leadership in Energy & Development Design Gold-Certified and the envy of the community, complete with a wonderful media center, gymnasium, cafeteria, playground, and other support spaces for children, teachers, and school administration. The magnet program presents the GPS curriculum in a holistic, inquiry-based framework, making connections among subject areas with an emphasis on global perspectives. NLS offers world language instruction in Spanish in grades K-5.

Overview of the Greenwich Public Schools Magnet Application Guidelines

The Greenwich Board of Education offers four magnet elementary schools and one magnet middle school that accept students through an application process. The magnet school program is designed to serve three purposes:

1. To advance and enhance student achievement by providing parents and students with educational options. Each magnet school offers a range of distinct education programs. Some emphasize particular academic subjects, while others use specific instructional approaches. Parents are encouraged to apply to those schools that they believe best meet the needs and interests of their children;
2. To support the racial, ethnic, and economic diversity of all of the district's schools while complying to racial balance requirements established by the Connecticut legislature and the State Board of Education; and,
3. To optimize the use of school facilities by balancing the distribution of students among elementary schools.

Programs and Services: GPS magnet schools provide the same curriculum, programs and services as all other Greenwich public elementary/middle schools. In addition, magnet schools offer a particular instructional framework and/or features that are unique to the individual schools.

Lottery Process: Each of the GPS magnet schools is also a neighborhood school, with students enrolled from within the designated attendance area. A limited number of magnet seats are available by application for students residing outside the magnet schools' attendance areas. If more applications are received than there are seats available, a lottery is conducted. The magnet school application deadline is February 1, 2024. **Western Middle School will not be accepting new students through the magnet program this year (unless they have a sibling already attending), due to temporary capacity challenges.**

Applicant Eligibility: Any resident of the Town of Greenwich with school-age children is eligible to apply to a GPS magnet school. Non-resident Town of Greenwich (TOG) employees are also eligible to apply to GPS magnet schools. Non-resident TOG applications will be considered after Greenwich resident applications are filled.

In 2000, The International School at Dundee (ISD) was the first magnet school to open in Greenwich and chose the International Baccalaureate Program as its magnet theme. The school was one of the first elementary schools in the country to become an authorized IB school. It has continued to successfully implement the program, which focuses on the development of the whole child and incorporates the teaching of the GPS curriculum through an inquiry-based framework. A Connecticut School of Distinction, ISD offers world language instruction in Spanish in grades K-5, as well as grade level partnerships with highly regarded institutions, such as the Guggenheim Museum and the Audubon Center.



STEAM Magnet School



Hamilton Avenue School (HAS) is the District's first Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Mathematics (STEAM) school. STEAM education ignites interest and uses an inquiry approach to develop the skills and knowledge that prepares students for expanding college and career opportunities. Among the more recently upgraded schools to become a state-of-the-art building with a design lab, HAS was one of the first Greenwich Public Schools to launch a Digital Learning Environment. HAS offers world language instruction in Spanish in grades K-5, Suzuki Violin (PreK-5), and a smaller average class sizes in grades K and 1.
