# P.E. WAIVER

- Students can earn the P.E. Waiver by:
  - (2) seasons of a sport
    - Same sport or two different sports
      - Example: 1 season Cross Country & 1 season Track
  - (2) seasons of Marching Band
  - (2) years of Show Choir
  - (2) years of Jr. ROTC

- College Prep Courses vs. Honors Courses

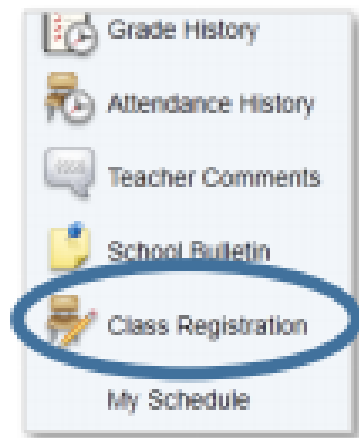
# ENTERING REQUESTS IN POWERSCHOOL

## How to Register for Classes

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Use the following procedure to request classes:

1. In the myOLSD portal, click on the **PowerSchool (Student)** icon and log in.
2. After you log in, click on **Class Registration**.

3. In the appropriate course groups, click on the **Pencil** icon.

# WHEN IS IT AND WHAT DO I NEED?

- We will meet with you to confirm your requests on the following dates:
  - OOMS – January 18<sup>th</sup>
  - OBMS - January 20<sup>th</sup>
- Students must bring their COMPLETED scheduling worksheet on their assigned day to meet with their high school counselor



# COURSE REQUEST VERIFICATION

- There will be a form to change course requests in student services
  - Changes to your requests after the master schedule is created may significantly reduce your chance of receiving all of your requests
- Student requests close May 26, 2022
- After this date, students will need to wait until the first day of school to make a change to their schedule

# SUGGESTIONS FOR 9TH GRADERS

## *Think about:*

- Completing graduation requirements early
  - Fine Arts (Visual or Performing)
  - Health (In-person or online)
  - PE (In-person, online, or Waiver)
- World Language
  - Colleges like to see (3) years of a world language at the high school level

## *Elective Suggestions:*

- Post-Secondary Planning
  - Create a graduation plan
- Service Learning
  - Earn volunteer hours
- Intro to Theatre
  - .5 credit toward fine art requirement
- Etymology
  - ACT/SAT prep



# SUGGESTIONS FOR 9TH GRADERS

## *Prerequisites:*

- Introduction to Journalism
  - If you are interested in Newspaper or Broadcast
- CAD I
  - Engineering / Industrial Tech
- Art I
  - Required for all other visual art courses

## *Other Suggestions:*

- Online Health and PE
  - Does not take up space in the school day
- Jr ROTC
- Olentangy Academy - STEM Program



# AEROSPACE AND LEADERSHIP - JR ROTC

- An accredited citizenship and character building program offered at Delaware Hayes HS for OOHS students
- Integrates aerospace education, citizenship, leadership, team-building skills, and voluntary community service
- 2 years of JR ROTC will qualify you for the P.E. Waiver





# EARLY RELEASE/LATE ARRIVAL

- Need to have transportation to school or home
- You cannot stay in the building with a late arrival/early release
- Plan for this period on your request sheet
- Have a parent/guardian SIGN your scheduling worksheet giving you permission to request an early release/late arrival
