

2022-2023 KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION BETHLEHEM ELEMENTARY SCHOOL MITCHELL ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

<u>Online Registration</u> for children in Bethlehem and Woodbury who will be attending Kindergarten for the **2022-2023 school year** will be opening on January 19th. All children who will be five years old during the 2022 calendar year are eligible for Kindergarten.

If your child is currently enrolled in the Region 14 Preschool program, please do not complete the online registration form. Contact the school office for more information.

As a part of online registration, the following items are required to complete the registration process:

- o a copy of the child's birth certificate
- 3 proofs of residency (see below)
 - Mortgage OR Lease OR Affidavit of Residency AND 2 of the following:
 - Utility Bill OR Driver's License [stickers are not accepted] OR Pay Stub OR Bank Statement
- o a copy of your child's current health form/immunizations
- o custodial papers if applicable

There will also be a Kindergarten orientation held Tuesday June 7th from 3:30 - 4:30. More information to follow.

Children will need a physical examination within one year of the first day of school, and all required immunizations must be documented before starting kindergarten. Health Assessment forms as well as residency requirements will be available on the Region's website <u>here</u>.
