### **What do students do in the time between the end of school and start of classes?**

Students who are enrolled in classes after school will go to the bathroom, wash hands and get a snack during the time in between school ending and class starting. You do not need to register for Extended Day to utilize this time.

### **How will Enrichment Classes safeguard against COVID-19?**

All COVID-19 protocols at Academy of the Sacred Heart will remain in effect during Enrichment classes. Students will be required to wear masks while indoors and will have the option to remove masks if outside and practicing social distancing. Appropriate hygiene practices will be followed and routine cleaning of the space and equipment will take place daily.

### **If I enroll my child in a class, do I also need to sign them up for Extended Day?**

If you are planning on picking up your child as soon as their class ends, you do not need to sign them up for Extended Day. Children will be escorted through the East Circle doors at the end of class to meet their parents. If you will **not** be picking your child up when their class ends, please also sign them up for Extended Day. ECP families do not need to sign their children up for Extended Day services as it is a separate program that applies to Primary and Lower School families!



### **Do I need to send my student with anything special for Enrichment Classes?**

Students will be provided with a snack before all classes begin and should plan on bringing their water bottle to class. Dance apparel requirements are listed in each class description; please make sure dancers bring their clothes with them each week to class. Students are welcome to bring a change of clothes for sports, but it is not required. Otherwise, school clothes and masks are appropriate for Enrichment Classes.
