PRESENTATION:

"Project Lead the Way BIOMED" presented by Mrs. Kowalski and her students.

With the help of about 20 students, Mrs. Kowalski presented the Project Lead the Way- BioMed Program. The Biomed program started at PHS in the 2017/2018 school year and had expanded each year. Currently, approximately 120 students are enrolled in the program. Most students start the program in their freshman year so they can complete the entire program when they are a senior.

The BioMed Program is a four-year progressive program that allows students to see themselves in the roles of biomedical science professionals as they solve real-world challenges, such as preventing, diagnosing, and treating disease and investigating the death of a fictional person. The courses progress in a specific sequence, as each one builds on the knowledge gained by students in the previous courses. The courses include "Principles of Biomedical Science", "Human Body Systems", "Medical Interventions", and "Biomedical Innovations".

For the presentation, multiple stations were set up to demonstrate the hands-on learning that occurs in the classroom. CAC members walked from station to station, listening to brief student presentations. Members then could experience biomedical equipment and use it in role-played procedures and experiments.
