
JEREMY R. PIEPER SCHOLARSHIP

Jeremy Pieper was a St. Croix Lutheran student who embraced SCLA's mission of developing soul, mind, and body. Jeremy valued highly the Christian education offered him at SCLA, maintaining a 3.8 GPA. During his sophomore year, Jeremy was inducted into the National Honor Society. Jeremy took an active part in student government at SCLA. He was elected vice-president of his freshman class and president of his sophomore class. Jeremy also served on Student Council. Athletically, Jeremy competed in football, basketball, and track. He was a starting player on his freshman and junior varsity basketball teams. As a sophomore, Jeremy was captain of the junior varsity football team. In August 1987, he earned a starting position on SCLA's varsity football team. On August 29, 1987, Jeremy was killed in an automobile accident.

Memorial gifts of friends and relatives have been set aside to establish the Jeremy R. Pieper Scholarship Fund at St. Croix Lutheran Academy. This scholarship is awarded to outstanding Crusaders who demonstrate, as Jeremy did in his life, that they appreciate their God-given abilities and their opportunity to develop and use them at St. Croix Lutheran Academy.
