- Financial Review
- Increase budget amount for Field Trips/Assemblies
 - Currently \$2000, pre covid it was \$5000
 - First Grade requested help funding their Lake Erie Nature & Science Center field trips in November. We agreed to pay a little over 40% of the cost. For each student, PTO paid \$4.20 and the student paid \$6.00. Total cost per student was \$10.20.
 - Kindergarten has asked for help with their field trip to the Science Center in Cleveland. The cost would be \$5 per student for 250 students = \$1000
 - Suggest increasing the budget to \$5 per student each year going forward. For this year that would be approx 1100 kids so \$5500, could round to \$6000 just to be safe.
