



Program Enhancement

For her Victorian Literature class, Helana Brigman received funds for the costuming of "A Night at Pemberley" — a historical reenactment project in which students recreated a night from Jane Austen's novel, *Pride and Prejudice*, immersing themselves in the customs, clothing, and cultural traditions of the British Regency. Students had the choice to make a gentleman's tailcoat or a lady's evening dress,

complete with lining, buttons, and decorative elements such as lace or



embroidery. The project allowed students to expand their understanding of Jane Austen's novel outside of the pages of the book, gaining new insights into the physical restrictions of women's and men's clothing

and the manners that accompanied this form of dress. Because dancing and music were such a significant part of nineteenth-century courtship, each students' costume helped them to participate in Austen's drawing-room etiquette.



Student Assistance

The MSSM Foundation is committed to making the MSSM's programs accessible to all students, regardless of their financial need. Each year through the thoughtful generosity of individuals and businesses, room and board assistance is provided to MSSM students whose need is not fully met by traditional financial aid. In addition, the Foundation provided the registration fee for two students to join several of their fellow KEY club members at the annual District Convention in Springfield, MA.

Facilities and Equipment

The MSSM maintenance team renovated existing storage space in the Veterans' Gym and the Foundation provided funds to outfit the new fitness center with high quality treadmill and cycling fitness machines.









