
QUESTIONS ABOUT LEVIES

The EP&O and Technology levies provide roughly 13 percent of RSD's annual budget. Without that amount, the district would have to trim about \$30 million from student program budgets.

Richland School District's Educational Programs & Operations (EP&O) levy pays for:

- Rigorous course offerings such as Advanced Placement (AP) and College In The High School
- Elementary art and music as well as comprehensive arts programs in middle and high schools
- Coaches for middle and high school athletics and activities
- Curricula and instructional materials
- Extra math and reading support

The EP&O levy is \$2.50 per \$1,000 in assessed property value.




Richland School District's Technology Levy is critical to ensuring students receive a 21st century education. The levy pays for each student in grades 2-12 to have their own laptop computer to support learning, collaboration and engagement with their classmates and teachers. The levy also pays for IT support for students and families, enhanced technology infrastructure and staff training. The Technology levy is \$0.50 per \$1,000 in assessed property value.

Did you know that state tax dollars only provide enough funding for two school nurses to serve all 19 Richland School District schools? And only half the staff needed to serve the district's hundreds of students with disabilities? RSD's EP&O levy fills the gap in paying these staff members, along with social workers, school psychologists, security staff, in-school community advocates and more.
