COVID-19

WHAT HAPPENS IF A STUDENT IS IN CONTACT WITH A STUDENT SICK OF COVID-19? (STUDENT OF THE SAME CLASS OR CONTACT AT RISK *)

Performing a self-test ** immediately

If the self-test ** is negative

- No quarantine Continuation of courses face-to-face
- Self-monitoring with two selftests ** on D + 2 and D + 4 after the first test

Declaration on honor to be provided to the school by the legal representatives attesting to the negative result of the first self-test and engagement to perform self-tests

The student becomes a confirmed case

If one of the self-tests is positive

• 7-day isolation that can be reduced to 5 days if a test antigen or PCR carried out at 5_e day is negative and in the absence of symptoms for 48 hours

If the student does not take a test antigenic or PCR

• 7-day isolation

Students infected with Covid-19 less than 2 months ago can continue face-to-face lessons without testing, unless symptoms appear.

If a new case appears within a period of less than 7 days,

re-screening is not necessary.

The legal representatives are given the self-tests free of charge at the pharmacy

on presentation of the letter delivered by the school.
