**MIDDLE SCHOOL HIGH SCHOOL : WHAT HAPPENS IF
A STUDENT IS IN AT-RISK * CONTACT WITH
A STUDENT SICK OF COVID-19?**

**STUDENTS UNDER
FROM 12 YEARS**

**STUDENTS AGE 12 AND
OVER COMPLETELY
VACCINATED**

**STUDENTS AGE 12 AND OVER
NOT VACCINATED OR
PARTLY VACCINATED**

Performing a self-test ** immediately

Mandatory isolation
7 full days from the last risky
contact
with the confirmed case

If the self-test is negative

- **No isolation**- Continuation of face-to-face lessons
- **Self-monitoring by two self-tests ** on D + 2 and D + 4 after the first test**
Declaration on honor to present attesting to the negative result of the first self-test and the commitment to perform self-tests on D + 2 and D + 4

**Mandatory completion
of a test on the 7th^e day
after last contact with
the confirmed case**

If one of the self-tests is positive

- **The student becomes a confirmed case**
- **7-day isolation** can be reduced to 5 days in case of antigenic test or PCR negative and in the absence of symptoms for 48 hours

If the test is negative

**Sworn statement
to be provided by
legal representatives**

Continuation of isolation until
production of a certificate
on honor

**The legal representatives receive the self-tests free of charge
in pharmacy** on presentation of the letter delivered by the establishment

If the test is positive

**The pupil becomes a case
confirmed**

- **10-day isolation**
- **Lifting of isolation possible
after 7 days**
with result of an antigen test
or PCR negative and in the
absence of symptoms for 48 hours

** Close contact with a confirmed case, without one of the two people wearing a mask providing filtration greater than 90%*

*** Monitoring can also be done by an antigen test or, failing that, PCR (in the latter case, the result must be obtained before the resumption of classes)*
