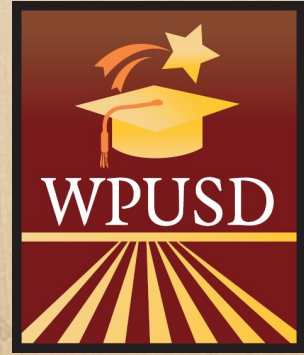

What is TK?

Structured Pre-K program that prepares students for kindergarten through the development of:

- Attention/focus skills
- Social skills
- Academic skills



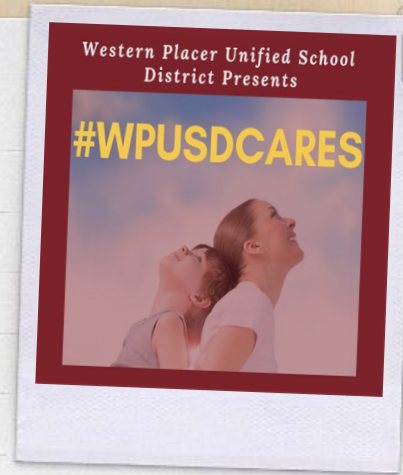
TK Eligibility

- Originally for students who turn 5 on or between Sept 2, 2022 and Feb 2, 2023
- In WPUUSD, students who turn 5 on or before Feb 2 will be guaranteed a spot in TK
- Students who turn 5 after Feb 2nd will be accepted on a space available basis



TK in WPUUSD

- A district program. Classes are at most elementary schools.
- Locations for 2022-2023 are not yet set
- Classes are a maximum of 24 students
- Student placement considerations:
 - Birthdate
 - Home school
 - Siblings
 - Date registration was received
 - Space availability



TK Daily Schedule

x PM 11:20 - 2:40 (10:20 - 1:40 on early
release days)

--Includes a snack break and recess

--Students work on pre-reading and literacy
skills, build background knowledge, and learning
through cooperative work and play
