Who can register?

Groton residents ages 17 or older who have not completed high school and live within the boundaries of Groton Public Schools.

For those students who are currently 17, parent permission is required to register. ESL and Citizenship classes are also open to immigrants seeking to become citizens or wanting to learn English.

What do I need to register?

Two Forms of Identification—A driver's license, library card, employee badge, or state ID

Proof of Address—A recent piece of mail addressed to the student, utility bill, or rent receipt

School Transcripts (If Available)—Any past school records such as transcripts, report cards or name/address of the last school attended is helpful in enrolling but not required.

When and where are classes held?

Classes will be held Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday evenings from 5:30–8:30 PM at Robert E. Fitch High School. Visit www.grotonschoools.org/adulted for the calendar.

Groton residents may also attend classes in New London through a partnership with New London Adult & Continuing Education.

GED and ESL classes have an open enrollment policy anytime during normal evening class hours, throughout the school year.
