Good Morning TUSD Families,

Last night the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) updated their guidance to schools regarding student contact tracing and notifications to families regarding possible COVID-19 Exposure. TUSD continues to follow the guidance of CDPH as we have throughout the COVID-19 pandemic. The following is a summary of changes to student contact tracing and family notifications:

- All families will be notified if an individual in an indoor school setting with their child has tested positive. This will be regardless of how close your child was in an indoor setting to a person who has tested positive for COVID-19.
- Your school will send out a notification to each family if there is a COVID-19 positive on campus with locations of possible exposures to COVID-19 positive individuals.
- Families will no longer receive different notifications based on types of possible exposure (masked vs. unmasked).
