Our Lady of Good Counsel Catholic School, established in 1957, is a parish preschool, elementary and middle school with approximately 500 students. The Virginia Catholic Education Association (VCEA) has accredited OLGC School since 1972.

OLGC School is also a member of the National Catholic Education Association (NCEA) and has been awarded U.S.

Department of Education Blue Ribbon School status.

The School provides a Catholic education instilled with the spirituality of St. Francis de Sales. It is intended to "make your child's faith a living, conscious, and active one through the light of instruction." The integration of religious truth and values with life is the focal point of the curriculum. As part of its educational program, OLGC School strives for academic excellence, encourages appreciation of the fine arts, fosters self-respect and respect for all life, and attempts to develop responsibility for the total community.

There are 18 classrooms, a computer lab, science lab, multi media center, music room, band room, art room, academic support center, foreign language room, math rooms, gymnasium, cafeteria, elementary playground, preschool playground, and playing fields. OLGC students have access to the following technology: the school-wide network, the Internet, desktop and laptop computers, iPad tablets, LCD and document projectors, wireless access, and interactive whiteboards. All middle school students are issued an iPad with keyboard or Chromebook for home and classroom use.

Community & Diocesan Updates

Statement by Bishop Michael F. Burbidge on Poverty Awareness Month 2022 It is fitting in January, as we continue our celebration of the birth of our Savior, that we also observe Poverty Awareness Month. Indeed, our Lord has a special love for the poor, and as his followers, so do we. We need not look far to see poverty, for it is visible all around us, in the lives of neighbors and, perhaps, in our own families. One in 10 Virginians lives in poverty. This poverty is most apparent when we see those who lack the material or financial resources they need to be well fed and to have safe shelter and meaningful employment that enables them to provide for themselves and their families and thrive in their daily lives. We also express concern for the physical, mental, and economic difficulties visited upon many of us because of the ongoing pandemic. We especially must be mindful of those around us who struggle every day with a deep spiritual poverty because they do not know the sustaining power, mercy and love of our God. Our hope, however, is always in the Lord. As the Psalmist says, "He shall rescue the poor when he cries out, and the afflicted when he has no one to help him" (Ps 72:1-2). Let it be our mission this month and always to bring the light of Christ to the materially and spiritually poor among us, whether this be through our own work, generosity, or evangelistic witness, or through your parish or Catholic Charities. Through prayer and the grace of God, we can be the instruments of his tender care.

The program is open to anyone 50 years of age or older. It has always been a stimulating experience and a perfect antidote to isolation, which has affected a lot of people as a result of the pandemic.

FAIRFAX CAREGIVER ALERT NOTIFICATIONS – If they can't reach you, they can't alert you. Now, family caregivers can receive email or text notifications of Fairfax County caregiver services and programs. These programs include case management, in-home respite, caregiver support and webinars, wellness workshops, and much more. Visit FairfaxCounty.gov/Alerts to create or sign into your Fairfax Alerts account and then select Area Agency on Aging.

FREE LEGAL SERVICES - Legal Services of Northern Virginia is a free resource for eligible applicants in Fairfax County (and all of Virginia). Its intake team will ask you a few questions to determine your eligibility. The questions will be about demographic information on household size, income, and asset information. They'll also conduct a check for conflicts of interest and get a brief description of your problem. So, if you're looking for legal help with a simple will or power of attorney or just befuddled about guardianship and advanced directives, call them at 703-779-6800. Attorneys and paralegals can assist with phone advice or even court presentation where needed. The program serves Virginians 60 and older as well as those

calling on their behalf. Callers can also request help with financial exploitation, landlord/tenant problems, family law, public benefits, tax issues, and consumer issues. Call the number above or apply online at LSNV.org.

HAVING DIFFICULTY PREPARING MEALS? – The Meals on Wheels program provides nutrition services for those 60 years of age or older as well as younger individuals who may have a disability and are temporarily unable to prepare meals for themselves. Weekly meals are available for in-home delivery. Priority is given to older adults with the greatest economic and social needs with an emphasis on individuals with low income, individuals in underserved communities, older individuals, minority individuals, older individuals with limited English, and individuals at risk for institutional placement. The program supports eligible adults to remain independent in their homes and currently provides a weekly, contact-free delivery of 11 flash-frozen meals. They're delivered one time per week. Apply by calling the Department of Family Services at 703-324-5409.

ARE YOU ELIGIBLE FOR SNAP? – The Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) is used like cash to buy food from authorized retailers and online from Amazon, Walmart, and more. It cannot be used for delivery fees. Recipients receive an Electronic Benefits Transfer card. Your account is debited when eligible food items are purchased. A Personal Identification Number is required. Households must meet certain requirements to qualify. Apply at CommonHelp.Virginia.gov or call 1-855-4370. For details, call the Customer Care Line, 703-324-7500, TTY711.

AGING SURVEY – Fairfax County will survey thousands of residents ages 50 and older to learn more about the aging experience in the Fairfax area. The information will be used to create the SHAPE the Future of Aging Plan for a more aging-friendly community. The SHAPE the Future of Aging Survey will be sent to a group of randomly selected adults in February. The survey will ask information about the lifestyles of the individuals, including opportunities to work, socialize, and volunteer; issues facing these adults such as retirement, housing, and caregiving; and their usage of community services such as public transportation and Senior Centers. The 50+ Community Survey was administered in 2019, and the results were used to formulate the 50+ Community Action plan to address initiatives around housing, transportation, safety, health, and community engagement. If you receive one of these surveys, you're encouraged to complete it so the County will be better able to plan for older citizens in the future.
