DECISION PROCESS FOR STUDENTS WITH COVID-19 SYMPTOMS OR EXPOSURE

If a student is experiencing symptoms consistent with COVID-19

Symptoms associated with COVID-19 include fever above 100 °F, unusual fatigue, chills, unexplained muscle aches, atypical headache, new or worsening cough, difficulty breathing, new loss of taste or smell, unexpected sore throat, congestion or runny nose

The student will be sent home and COVID test recommended

Does not seek evaluation and/or COVID-19 test from a healthcare provider

Treat as a POSITIVE COVID-19 test result

Receives POSITIVE COVID-19 test result

Receives NEGATIVE COVID-19 test result or alternative diagnosis from healthcare provider

Return to school when:
• At least 24 hours have passed without a fever without the use of fever reducing medication
• And other symptoms have improved

If a student tests positive for COVID-19

Isolate at home

Return to school and end isolation when:

- AFTER 5 days from positive test result, if symptoms are no longer present AND you get a negative test result on day 5
- AFTER 10 days from positive test result, without negative test if fever has resolved, even if other symptoms continue
- AFTER MORE than 10days if fever persists more than 10 days from positive test result. Student must be fever free 24 hours before returning.

If a student is exposed in close contact with someone who tests positive for COVID-19

Close contact means being within 6 feet of someone who tests positive for COVID-19 for at least 15minutes. We will notify parents directly if their student has been in close contact with a confirmed case of illness. This exposure also includes anyone who lives in the same household.

The student is vaccinated for COVID-19 or has fully recovered from a confirmed case of COVID-19 within the past 90 days

The student does not need to quarantine as long as they remain asymptomatic

The student is NOT vaccinated for COVID-19

Both parties were masked if exposed indoors

Modified 10-day quarantine allows student to continue attending school in person as long as they:
• get tested twice weekly during the 10 days
• remain asymptomatic
• continue to mask as required
• quarantine from all extracurricular activities at school (including sports) and from all community activities

Both parties were NOT masked indoors

With NO testing: Quarantine and then return to school 10 days after exposure if no symptoms appear (If exposed at home, ALL 10 days must be fully isolated from infected family member to count)

Quarantine. With a negative COVID test on day 5 from last exposure: return to school on day 6 if no symptoms appear. (If exposed at home, days from last exposure cannot be counted unless fully isolated from infected family member)
