 - **Describe something you have done in the past year that has made a difference in your community.**
 - **Describe how you have demonstrated leadership ability in your school, work, or community.**
 - **Discuss a special attribute or accomplishment that sets you apart.**
 - **Pick an experience from your own life and explain how it has influenced your development.**

Scholarship funds may be used for tuition, fees, books, room and board or for other items required by your college or university. If you are selected to receive a scholarship, you will be provided with instructions and a disbursement form to claim your scholarship. In some cases, these funds may be considered by the Internal Revenue Service as taxable income. Please consult your tax advisor.
