COVID DECISION TREE Revised January 14, 2022

EXPOSED TO COVID

Applies if you have been exposed* to Covid-19

I AM UNVACCINATED OR IT HAS BEEN **GREATER THAN 6 MONTHS SINCE MY** LAST COVID VACCINE (2 MONTHS FOR J&J):

I HAVE BEEN FULLY VACCINATED FOR LESS THAN 6 MONTHS OR I HAVE RECEIVED THE BOOSTER OR IT HAS BEEN LESS THAN 90 DAYS FROM MY LAST COVID DIAGNOSIS:

COVID POSITIVE

Applies to all individuals regardless of vaccine status or previous Covid diagnosis

ISOLATE FOR 5 DAYS

Day 0 is your first day of symptoms or a positive viral test. Day 1 is the first full day after your symptoms developed or your test specimen was collected.

*Per CDC, exposure is close contact of 6 feet or less for 15 minutes or more.

Quarantine for 5 days. Day 0 is the last day of contact with a person with Covid-19. You may return to school on day 6 if you meet the following return to school criteria:

- I am asymptomatic
- I have a negative Covid test taken on Day 5 or later of quarantine (no home tests) and have emailed the results to the school nurse (nurse-ls@bcsk12.org, nurse-us@bcsk12.org)
- I will wear a mask at school for the next 5 days

If you are unable to meet all of the return to school criteria you will be required to remain in quarantine for 10 days and may return to school on day 11

YOU ARE ABLE TO REMAIN IN SCHOOL IF YOU MEET THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

- I am asymptomatic
- I will mask for 10 days and may remove my mask on day 11
- provided I have a negative Covid test taken on Day 5 or later
- I have emailed my negative Covid results to the school nurse (no home tests) Nurses-Is@bcsk12.org for the lower school campus Nurses-us@bcsk12.org for the upper school campus
- If symptoms develop the individual will immediately quarantine until a negative test confirms the symptoms are not attributable to Covid
- If you are unable to meet all of the return to school criteria you will be required to continue isolation for 10 days at which time you may return to school on day 11 provided symptoms are resolved or improving and you have been fever-free for 48 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication

You may return to school on day 6 if you meet the following criteria:

- Symptoms have resolved or are significantly improving.
- Fever-free for 48 hours without the use of fever-reducing medications.
- I will mask at all times while at school for the next 5 days.
- If you are unable to meet all of the return to school criteria you will be required to continue isolation for 10 days at which time you may return to school on day 11 provided symptoms are resolved or improving and you have been fever-free for 48 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication
